

Colorado Short Course 14 & Under Silver State

DATE: February 23, 24, & 25, 2007

SANCTION: Held under sanction of Colorado Swimming, Inc. of USA Swimming # 2007-017

LOCATION: University of Denver, Coors Fitness Center
I-25 and University Blvd.,
2201 E. Asbury, Denver, CO 80208

FACILITIES: Elevation 5320 ft; Seventeen lane 25 yard by eight lane 50-meter indoor pool. Dependent upon number of entrants, the meet may run 1) in one 10 lane, 25 yard course, or in two courses, Course A=8 lane, 25 yard, Course B=6 lane 25 yard, with non-turbulent markers. Continuous warm-up/down lanes will be available in both circumstances.

TIMING: Colorado Timing System with touch pads and display board

SCHEDULE: **Friday, Saturday & Sunday 10-U, 11-12, 13-14**

Assigned Warm-up: Two 30-minute warm-ups beginning at 7:00 am

Teams will be notified with their warm-up schedule, unattached swimmers should report to the meet referee for assignment.

Meet Start: 8:10 am.

ELIGIBILITY:

All athletes *must* hold a 2007 USA Swimming membership card issued by Colorado Swimming, Inc. Swimmers who are within the 120-day transfer rule must swim UNATTACHED. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI exception report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their current card or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. A surcharge for deck registration will also apply, \$27.00 plus normal registration fee. Exception report will be posted on the CSI web page after the entry deadline, at csi.org.

SCORING: There will be no scoring.

AWARDS: Individual: Medals 1-8 Ribbons 9-16

SEEDING PROCEDURE & SCRATCH RULES:

The meet shall be pre-seeded. Swimmers must report to the assigned heat and lane if they intend to swim the event.

RULES:

1. Current 2007 USA Swimming Rules & Regulation will govern the meet.

2. Age as of the first day of the meet will determine the swimmer's age group for competition. February 23, 2007.

3. ***Submit entry times according to the time swam – DO NOT SUBMIT CONVERTED TIME, e.g., if the Q time was done in long course meters submit the long course time.***

4. No exhibition swimming is allowed.

5. All events are timed final events. All entries must be legible with name of swimmer, event and description with the entry time. A "blank space" or NT will not be accepted. No refunds will be given for incorrect entries.

6. The meet is pre-seeded; please notify the Clerk of Course of scratches only. Swimmers shall report promptly to the blocks prior to the start of each race in which they are entered. Any swimmers not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized.

7. This is a qualifying meet. All entry times will be verified with the CSI time's database before the swimmer will be allowed to swim that event. No qualifying times will be accepted unless meet results are in the CSI proof of time database or times can be verified through SWIMS. A no proof of times report will be posted on the CSI web page after the entry deadline at csi.org. Team Entry Chair or coaches will then have 48 hours to correct or provide proof of time. Times must have been achieved between February 24, 2006 and February 15, 2007. **NOTE: Submit entry times according to the time swum - NO CONVERSIONS Non-conforming times will be seeded last.**

If a swimmer has a proof of time and it is not in the CSI data base hard copy proof must be submitted with the entry.

8. The MEET REFEREE will have the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet.

9. Colorado Swimming, Inc. procedures for warm-up will be observed.

10. At the Referee's discretion, individual events may be combined by age, sex and/or distance.

11. The USA Swimming National Start will be used. This meet will enforce timely reporting to the block area and responding promptly to signals and commands as follows: When the swimmers and officials are ready, the Referee shall signal with an out stretched arm to the starter that the swimmers are under the Starter control (102.14.4B). Swimmers stepping up late after the Referee has signaled with an outstretch arm releasing the field to the Starter "may," at the discretion of the referee, be barred from competing in that event. It is the responsibility of every swimmer and coach to ensure that they report to the starting area in a timely fashion and respond to all signals and commands of the meet officials promptly.

12. All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches that are in non-compliance will not be allowed on deck.

13. Participating teams will be assigned lanes for timing and are expected to provide the timer(s) for the duration of the assignment.

DISTANCE EVENTS:

1. The distance events 400 IM/500 Free will be deck seeded by positive check in on the day the event will be swum. The swimmer or their coach must check in at the clerk of course by 9:00 am on the day of the event. The 500 freestyle will swim fastest to slowest alternating women and men.

2. 500 SWIMMERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TIMERS (2) AND COUNTER. 400 IM SWIMMERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TIMER.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter four (4) individual events per day, with a maximum of nine (9) events in the meet.

ENTRY FEES:
\$5.00 for each individual event. (50 cents of each individual event will go to the CSI Support Fund)
Pool Surcharge: \$ 5.00 per swimmer.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:
Entries may be sent using HY-TEK MEET MANAGER DISK and/or COMMLINK FILE on a 3.5-inch disk or email in USA Swimming SDIFv3 complete with all required information (name, team, USA number, time, age, and event number). Also be sure to include a hard copy printout of the team entry report and team roster report in duplicate. CLUBS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INTEGRITY OF THEIR DISK!

IF YOU DO **NOT** USE THE HY-TEK ENTRY FORMAT all entries must be on pink and/or blue CSI master entry sheets. These sheets must include the swimmer's name, age, correct USA#, approved team code, event #, and entry time. "N.T." and incorrect entries will be rejected! A separate master sheet for EACH age group and sex is required with swimmers listed alphabetically. These sheets are to be sent in duplicate to the Entry Chairman, as listed below.

All entries must include preparer's name, phone number; coach's name, phone number, and e-mail. All entries must be sent to entry chairman, do not send to the pool.
N.T., INCORRECT ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES WITHOUT EXISTING PROOF OF TIME WILL BE REJECTED 48 HOURS AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE IF NO CORRECTION IS MADE

Colorado Meet Verification Forms and checklists must accompany all entries.

ENTRY DEADLINE:
The entry chairman must receive hand delivered or mailed entries including checks and hard copies by **Thursday February 15th at 6:00 pm.** (Overnight mail or guaranteed next day delivery is acceptable if agent guarantees next day delivery to satisfy meet deadline.)

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER ENTRY DEADLINE.

EXCEPTION: Only those swimmers achieving a qualifying time at the last chance meets the weekend after the deadline. This is only for those swimmers that had not previously qualified in that event. No previous times will be adjusted. The Meet Director will be collected entries and fees and forward to the entry chairman.

Entries will be posted on the Colorado Swimming web page at csi.org. The team coach and/or entry chairperson will then have 48 hours from the time of posting to make corrections. All incorrect entries will be deleted from the meet after that time.

Any questions regarding the conduct of this meet should be directed to the meet referee.

SAFETY ISSUES :

- ❑ All coaches, officials, parents and swimmers should act in a manner to reduce the risk of any accidents.
- ❑ Swimmers are **required** to enter the water *feet first* and it is preferred that they **slip-&-slide into the water during warm-ups!** That is, sit down on the side of the pool and slip/slide into the water.
- ❑ Coaches are to monitor their swimmers during warm-up/meet and are responsible for their safety.
- ❑ No forward dives or backstroke starts into the water during warm-up unless there is one-way swimming & starts with coach supervision.
- ❑ All athletes, visiting coaches and officials are reminded that the swimming venue may have areas where additional care needs to be observed. This includes and is not limited to slippery deck, bleachers and hallways. Proper footwear and caution “may” help reduce these risks.
- ❑ No running or horseplay is allowed and it is the responsibility of the swimmer, coach, officials and parents to monitor these activities.
- ❑ Care should be given not to park in either handicapped or fire lanes as vehicles may be towed at the owner’s expense.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL ON THE POOL DECK, IN THE BUILDING, OR ANY AREA FREQUENTED BY SWIMMERS.

Any damage to pool property will be grounds for dismissal from the remainder of the meet and the offenders will be held liable to the fullest extent, which the law allows.

PROGRAMS AND RESULTS:

The meet program/heat sheet and the final results will be provided for teams entered in the meet. Individuals wanting final results may place an order during the meet at the awards table for \$5.00. Results will be sent back to the clubs via their entry disk or email, hard copies will be sent upon request only.
